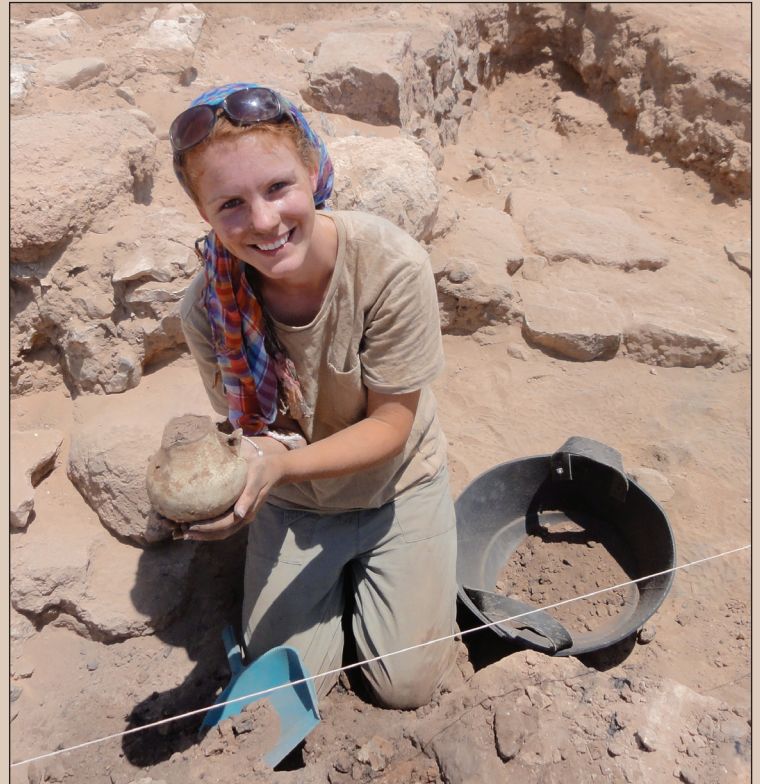

Students will be involved in all parts of the research, from collecting the data, to processing finds and analyzing information derived from the data.
