*Rita DE GRANDIS is a Professor of Spanish American Literature at the University of British Columbia. She is the author of 2 books, 2 co-edited books, and numerous articles and book chapters in peer-reviewed journals and books in English, Spanish, French and Portuguese.*

*Professor De Grandis has applied critical theory to modern and contemporary Latin American literature, cinema, and popular media. She has published extensively on a range of topics dealing with María Luisa Bemberg's cinema, Ricardo Piglia, José María Arguedas, Mario Vargas Llosa, Juan José Saer, Representations of Peronism at the end of the twentieth-century, questioning cultural hybridity, among others. In 2007 she was the recipient of the Best Book Prize from the Canadian Association of Hispanics.*
