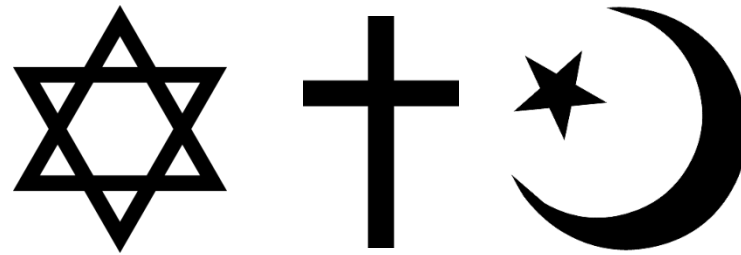


# Jewish, Christian and Muslim Perspectives on Peace and Justice
