

CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

The University of Waterloo, Theatre and Performance Program, invites applications to participate in the 2019 Prague Quadrennial of Performance Design and Space from June 7-12. PQ is the largest international festival of performance design featuring groundbreaking exhibitions, installations, workshops, seminars and more than 500 live performances with over 180,000 visitors and more than 1,300 students from around the world.

We are seeking students, recent graduates and emerging artists or collectives who are interested in applying for ONE of the following opportunities:

1. EXHIBITOR:

To exhibit performance design work in the Canadian National Student and Emerging Artist Exhibit. Proposals for new projects or previously completed work will be considered for the exhibit;

2. CREATIVE ASSISTANT:

To assist in the creation and realization of several creative projects featured as part of the Canadian Professional Exhibit, the Emerging Artists Exhibit, and the 36Q° large scale installation project.

If selected, participants will be expected to travel to Prague several days prior to the start of the festival on June 7th. Participants will also be expected to contribute their skills and knowledge to the realization of several creative projects from January-May 2019. We expect that travel and accommodation expenses will be covered by the University of Waterloo for current students.
