
## GLEN COULTHARD: THIRD WORLD INFLUENCES ON FOURTH WORLD ANTI-COLONIALISM: MAOIST INFLECTIONS



The uses of Marxism by Indigenous activists and scholars has been paradoxical: existing, but limited against when viewed other theoretical frameworks. In this talk the Dene scholar Glen Coulthard digs deeper into this, showing us how Indigenous activists Western Canada from the late 60s to the early 80s developed a placebased political framework that was deeply influenced by global decolonization movements. doing so he will reveal how Native people have created molded and adapted this framework to their unique contexts to further their own critiques of racial capitalism, patriarchy, and colonialism.
