

## **Middle Atlantic & New England Council for Canadian Studies (MANECCS) Young Scholars Grant Program**

### **Purpose**

The Young Scholars Grant Program helps offset travel costs for graduate students and junior faculty members who are interested in presenting their Canadian Studies-related research at the 2008 Middle Atlantic & New England Council for Canadian Studies (MANECCS) and Southern Association for Canadian Studies (SACS) Joint Conference to be held October 2–5, 2008 in Washington, DC. At least six grants of a maximum US\$500 per grant will be awarded.

### **Competition Timetable**

- Deadline for submission of paper proposals: May 1, 2008.
- Notification of grant recipients: May 15, 2008.
- Grant monies will be issued to recipients after completion of the Conference.

### **Eligibility**

- U.S. and non-U.S. (international) junior faculty members (i.e., faculty members who have not yet presented a paper at a regional or national Canadian Studies conference) and graduate students who are currently teaching or are enrolled at an institution within the MANECCS region.
- The paper must be an original composition developed by the author(s), never previously published or copyrighted.

### **Proposal Preparation Guidelines**

The paper proposal (no more than 2 pages) must include the following information: a) title; b) name and institutional affiliation; c) abstract (no more than 250 words); d) one-page curriculum vitae for each author. Proposals will be evaluated on the quality and originality of the proposed presentations as well their general potential for furthering Canadian Studies scholarship.
