Qualifications & Experience:

- 1) A Ph.D. or Ed.D. completed (or near completion).
- 2) An active research and publishing agenda in drama education.
- 3) Strong background in classroom pedagogy and experience teaching in the K-12 context.
- 4) Experience in post-secondary teacher education and background and experience in a second teaching area are desirable assets.
