## *Festival Theatre: Magnetic North Theatre Festival*

The Magnetic North Theatre Festival takes place in Ottawa this year, and students in this three-credit undergraduate course will explore its past, present and future during one intense week focusing on theatre history, performance analysis, and criticism. Students are expected to see all seven MNTF shows outside of class time (evenings and weekend) and must show proof of purchase of a Festival Pass, which is available at a discounted rate of \$125 (\$110 before May 15) for those registered in the course. Attendance at all lectures and workshops during the six classroom days is also required.
