Location

The field school is based at the East Sussex campus of Queen's University, the Bader International Study Centre. The BISC is located in Herstmonceux Castle, an hour and 20 minutes by train south of London. The ancient castle sits on 600 acres of parkland with extensive gardens and trails. The cities of Eastbourne, Hastings and Brighton are just a short drive away. In addition, students can easily participate in independent travel throughout Europe before or after the program.

Timing and Costs

Instruction at the Castle will begin on **August 11th**. The Field School will conclude on **August 26th** at the end of England's Medieval Festival. The total cost for the program is \$2,950 CAD. This includes tuition for 2 courses/6 units, residence and meals while at the Castle, field study trips, entrance fees, and scheduled shuttle service to and from the airport at the beginning and end of the Field School. Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from the UK, health and travel insurance, visas (if applicable) and personal spending money.
