# FUNDING PACKAGES

## Masters of Arts

The Centre for Drama guarantees funding for all full-time students who are enrolled in the MA program. In 2016-17, the funding package for domestic students will be \$15,000. Students are responsible for any course-related expenses, as well as payment of their tuition and fees. Tuition and fees are subject to change on an annual basis. ## Doctor of Philosophy

### Funding Package (Years 1-5)

The Centre for Drama guarantees funding for students during the first 5 years of the PhD program. Students are fully funded during years 1-4, and in year 5, the funding package is reduced by 50%.

In 2016-17, the funding package for domestic students will be \$15,000 plus the cost of tuition and fees.

Students in year 5 will receive \$7,500 plus half the cost of tuition and fees.
