SAMPLE SCHEDULE

Each forum consists of **7 sessions**: 3 group sessions (fixed times on first & last day) and 4 mentor sessions (flexible).

Prior to the Forum:

- Watch recommended videos on topics related to your writing goal (links to be provided).
- Prepare the work-in-progress manuscript (25-50 pp).

Day 1

- Introductions, info session, Q&A (1.5 hours)
- Participants' share their research with the group followed by a group discussion (2 hours)

Day 2

- One-on-one meeting with mentors (1 hour)
- Peer mentoring with other participants (1 hour)

Day 3

- Recommended free day to reflect on advice received.

Day 4

- One-on-one meeting with mentors (1 hour)
- Peer mentoring with other participants (1 hour)

Day 5

 Closing session, Q&A, and next steps to maintain mentor/mentee relationships until publishing goal is reached (1.5 hours)
