## Next General Meeting, Tuesday, February 12th, 2016 - 7:00pm

Prostate Cancer Canada Research Portfolio: From Discovery to Impact presented by Dr. Stuart Edmonds, *Vice President Research, Health Promotion and Survivorship* at Prostate Cancer Canada will cover:

- The prostate cancer research landscape in Canada
- How PCC makes decisions about research
- The difference PCC research investments are making



Dr. Edmonds joined Prostate Cancer Canada in February, 2012. Since then, he has spearheaded the launch of the **Research Strategic Plan**, providing the direction for research and survivorship activities for 2012-2015. From this plan, PCC has launched numerous new research programs based on the key pillars: Collaboration, Innovation and Talented People. Dr. Edmonds has also instituted a fair and transparent peer review process to steward and safeguard funds raised in support of prostate cancer research and to ensure that only the most promising, high quality research is funded.

Prior to joining PCC Dr. Edmonds held leadership roles at the **Canadian Cancer Society**, the **Canadian Partnership Against Cancer**, the **Canadian Cancer Research Alliance** and the **National Cancer Institute of Canada**. Dr. Edmonds holds a doctorate in pharmacology from **Oxford University**.

FLASH: On February 1, Rocco Rossi, *President and CEO of Prostate Cancer Canada* announced that **Dr. Paul Rennie** and **Dr. Artem Cherkason** have developed "...a new prostate cancer treatment that has consistently demonstrated in a lab setting that it provides a line of defense against even the most aggressive, resistant cancers.

"This particular treatment has shown so much promise that the pharmaceutical industry has deemed it worthy of moving into clinical trials. This may be the lifeline men with drug-resistant cancer have been waiting for. It's a real game changer, and I'm proud to say: This life-saving breakthrough is based on research people like you helped fund through Prostate Cancer Canada!"

Dr. Edmonds has agreed to provide us with more information on this particular research effort, which may eventually benefit some of our members!

## <u>Last General Meeting, Tuesday, January 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016</u>

As described at the last meeting, we have moved our monthly meetings to Norton Place Park Community Centre, 170 Clark Boulevard. It is NOT easy to find, being up a lengthy driveway across from the Brampton Transit barns at 185 Clark. The sign for the property is only visible once you turn into the narrow driveway just east of the Zoom Zoom Storage yard. (The Community Centre GPS coordinates are 43°42'27.5"N 79°43'39.5"W)

We started the meeting with a presentation by **Sean Friedman** from the *Recreation and Culture Division of the City Brampton*. He described the wide variety of programs that the City offers for older adults of all ages and physical levels. *Flower City Seniors Centre* is a one-stop experience that offers programming for everyone, but programs available at other locations throughout the City include drop-in billiards, fitness, walking, dominos, supper club, computer programs, arts and more. Sean also mentioned that they would undertake to offer courses on any subject. Perhaps it is time to request an exercise program specifically tailored to prostate cancer survivors.

The balance of the meeting was a lively "Stop, Start, Continue" discussion of what PCCN Brampton currently does and what we might do differently in the future to better support those affected by prostate cancer and to more efficiently increase public awareness of the disease.

By popular agreement, we will again be implementing:

- the name tags that we used for so many years and
- the monthly phone calls to remind members about the meetings.

The phone calls can only happen if we have sufficient volunteers to do the calling.
