If you decide to take part in the study, you would possibly participate in either of two ways:

- You may take part in a 60 minute telephone interview.
- You may be asked to keep a diary/journal for a week. You will be given a blank journal with some writing prompts.

There may be possible benefits if you take part in the study. Past participants have commented that the experience allowed them to gain a deeper understanding of themselves and that they appreciated the opportunity to express themselves in a special way.
