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PCS - Brampton News

You will notice the change in our masthead since our last Newsletter in March. PCCN Brampton is now PCS – Brampton, short for Prostate Cancer Support – Brampton. Despite its promises to leave Prostate Cancer Canada and the Prostate Cancer Canada Network alone for two years, the Canadian Cancer Society (CCS) recently informed all chapters that we must cease using the Prostate Cancer Canada Network name and the necktie logo by October 1st, 2020.

Although CCS later backtracked a little on the use of the PCCN name, many of the leaders of support groups in Ontario and elsewhere had already decided to change to group names that properly reflect what we do and where. The *Prostate Cancer Support – [Region]* convention has been adopted by a large number of the groups, not only because it makes sense but because we cannot be forced to change our name in the future at the whim of some larger organization.

After a good deal of activity by some dedicated people in Vancouver, BC and in Waterloo, ON, we have two choices available for a new logo. See the two options on Page 3.

The other major change of course, is that large in-person meetings are discouraged, so virtually all support groups across Canada have moved to hold virtual meetings. We are doing the same starting with our September 8th Member Meeting. See Page 2 for more information.

ADT Online Educational Program

These 1.5-hour online classes using the **GoToMeeting** platform are offered monthly to prostate cancer patients who have recently started or who are about to start hormone therapy and their partners. Space is limited and prioritized for Canadians, but if classes are not filled, citizens of other countries will be accepted.

Canadian participants receive a free copy of the book <u>Androgen Deprivation Therapy: An Essential Guide for Prostate Cancer Patients and Their Loved Ones</u>. [Editor's Note: The book is mentioned but the free part is no longer mentioned; we are attempting to confirm.]
